As stated is Section 2.3 - Cost Proposal & Acceptable Pricing Formats, "Bidders are required to use the template provided in Attachment B but are permitted to revise any part of spreadsheet in order to customize the cost proposal to accurately reflect the column titles, details, discounts, pricing categories of products, services, and solutions being offered to Equalis Group Members."

Question 4

Question 5

Question 6

At the top of this agreement is says Equalis Group, LLC and on page 7 it says Equalis Group, LTD. Our legal team is questioning how many entities Equalis has or is this just a typo?

Answer 6

Equalis Group, LLC is the entity. Appending Equalis Group with Ltd. was done in error.

Question 7

Can the admin fees be included in our discount?

Answer 7

Yes. The Admin Fee should be included in all pricing as outlined in Section 2.3 of the Main RFP document.

Question 8

Does Equalis Group prefer pricing that includes of exclude shipping cost?

Answer 8
