Coverage shall terminate upon the sale or other transfer of the product by the original end user. As used in this Limited Warranty, the word "defect" means imperfections in components which substantially impair the utility of the product. This warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights that vary from state to state.

# WHAT IS NOT COVERED?

This Limited Warranty applies only under conditions of normal intended use of the product and does not cover defects or conditions caused by, or resulting from, failure to follow product assembly or cleaning instructions or information on warnings, misuse, abuse, neglect, intentional or accidental damage, an act of God (including but not limited to, fire, flood, or earthquake), or any alteration or modification of the product. This Limited Warranty does not cover ordinary wear and tear from normal usage of the product. Any product that, in NorvaNivel's opinion, has been abused or mistreated will not be covered by this Limited Warranty. There is also no coverage for display or floor models or products purchased "as is".

This Limited Warranty provides no coverage for fabrics used in products. Fabrics used in NorvaNivel products are subject to a separate warranty provided by the fabric manufacturer and, to the extent possible, any such warranty will be passed on to the original end user from the manufacturer of the fabrics.
