

Mother Mary Lange Catholic School

As the first Catholic school built by the Archdiocese in Baltimore in over 60 years, the new Mother Mary Lange Catholic School (MMLCS) was designed to significantly improve the community's access to education. An 18-month study identified West Baltimore as the optimal location to support the neighborhood and contribute to its revitalization. Much of the design, fundraising, and planning was driven by community involvement.

The 65,000-square-foot school will serve more than 500 students from pre-K through eighth grade. For Price Modern, contributing to a project with such deep community impact held special meaning. We were honored to help create a space that will uplift future generations and support equitable access to learning.

Our team leveraged its extensive network of manufacturing partners to specify products from companies committed to supporting students and educators. Working closely with MMLCS and JMT Architecture, we selected furnishings that aligned with the school's vision and stayed within budget.

The facility includes 22 classrooms, a digital media center, STEM suite, makerspace, library, and robotics center. Flexible furnishings empower teachers to reconfigure their spaces to support diverse learning styles, while state-of-the-art technology helps students explore their interests and prepare for future success.
