Why Communication Matters for Adoption

Template 1: Initial Announcement

Subject Line Options:

- Track your child's bus in real-time starting [Date]
- New this year: Know exactly when the bus arrives
- [District Name] launches bus tracking for families

Email Body:

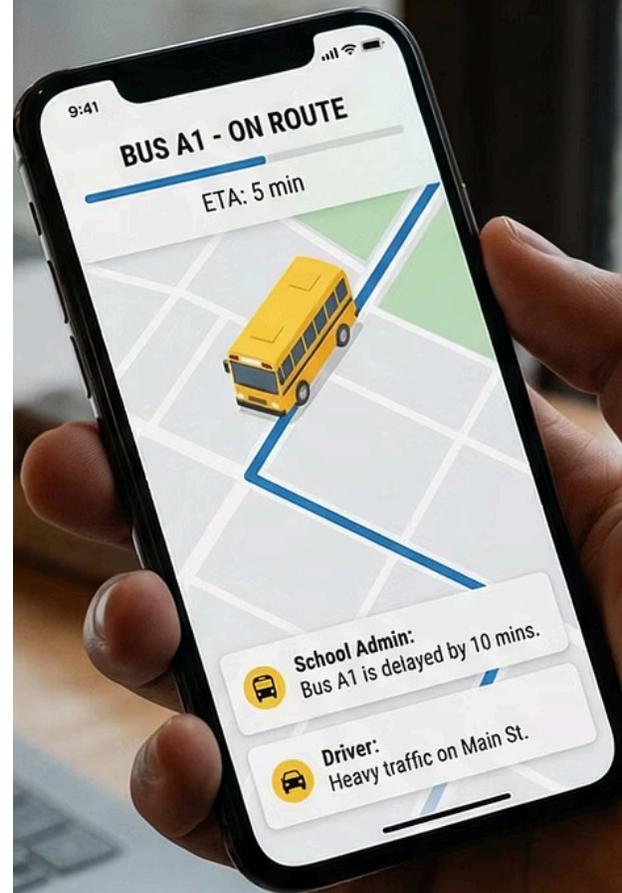

Frequently Asked Questions: Bus Tracking

Q: Is the app free?

A: Yes. The app is free for all [District Name] families.

Q: How accurate is the bus location?

A: The GPS updates every [X] seconds, so you see near real-time location. Actual arrival may vary slightly due to traffic.

Q: Can I track multiple students?

A: Yes. Add all your students to one account.

Q: What if I don't have a smartphone?

A: Yes. You can only view buses assigned to your registered students. No personal information is shared publicly.

Q: Who do I contact if I have problems?

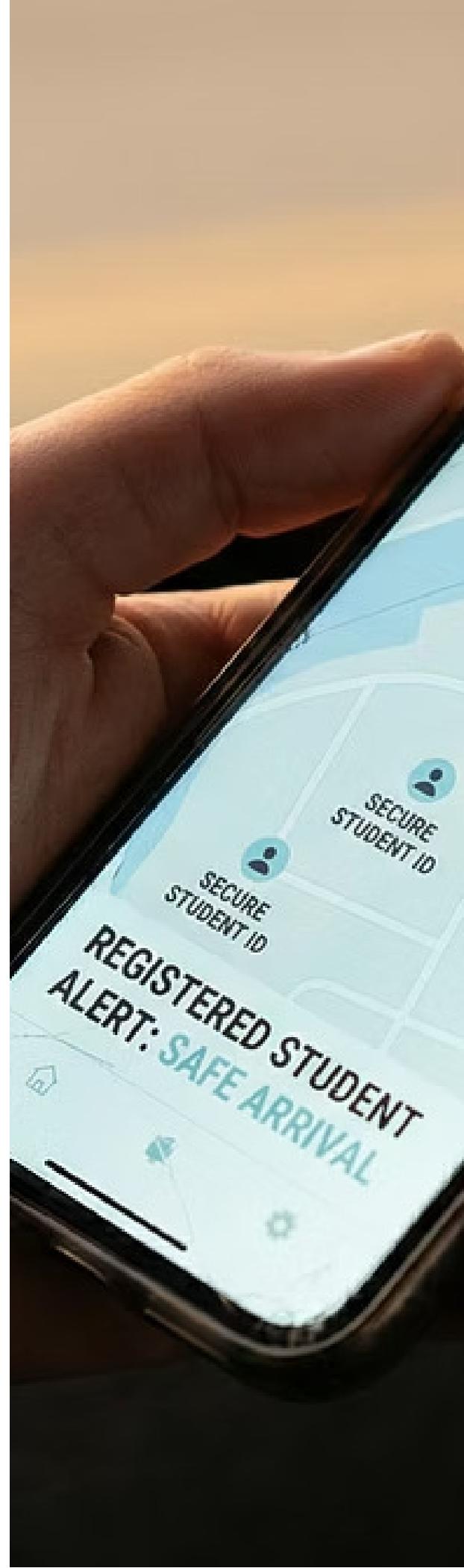

Tips For High Adoption

Districts that follow this approach consistently see 90%+ adoption rates. Here are key strategies:



Communicate early

Announce 2-3 weeks before school starts



Communicate often

Send reminders at 1 week, 3 days, and day before



Make it easy

Include direct download links every time



Show the value

Focus on "no more guessing" benefit



Provide support

Have a help line ready for setup issues



Use multiple channels

Email, text, social, flyers, website
